Aims of conference:

The International Conference on *Sustainable Development* is a platform for discussing current issues and trends in the sustainable development of EU regions. The conference also provides space for presenting research focused on practice in the fields of economics, management, political science, law and security sciences and space for responding to current events. In 2023, the conference aims to:

- Assess the impact of different crises (energy, financial, etc.) on citizens, companies, states and public budgets and their long-term sustainability.
- Assess the current situation, problems and challenges of the EU in 2023 (war in Ukraine, migration crisis, impacts of COVID-19, energy and food security, deepening the integration of the Czech Republic, the state of democracy in the EU, participation of citizens in European integration, Schengen, Europol, Eurojust, cooperation within selected EU policies, institutional reforms, different ideas about the future of the EU, sustainability of the EU's fundamental freedoms, internal and external security of the EU, development of European regions, etc.).
- Identify and analyse the possibilities of further qualitative and quantitative development of the standard of living of EU citizens in terms of current economic development.
- Characterize the overall strategic view of Europe and its future direction in the political, economic, social, security and environmental fields.
- Characterize current trends in security sciences in terms of detecting, clarifying, investigating and preventing crime or other anti-social activities.


- > panels I-VIII + plenary session + gala dinner 2,500 CZK (100 €),

- > contribution to be published without personal participation at the conference 1 000 Kč (40 €),
- > VŠERS staff do not pay the conference fee.

The fee includes organizational costs and costs associated with the publication of conference monographs, conference materials, food and refreshments during the conference (panels I-VIII including a social event in the evening). The cost of accommodation is not included. The fee is paid as one whole and cannot be split into individual items. If you do not attend the conference, the fee shall not be refunded. However, you can send someone else instead of you, if you tell us in advance. After paying the fee, one paper can be published and one person can attend the conference. Attendance at the conference is not conditioned by publishing a paper. Conference fees must be paid in advance by **30th September 2023**. Organizers reserve the right to cancel the registration in case the conference fee is not paid and not to include a speech or paper in the conference program and in the review procedure.

Instructions to authors of contributions:

- A contribution is to involve:
 - title in Czech (Slovak),
 - o title in English,
 - o identification of author including contact in Czech/Slovak,
 - o identification of author including contact in English,
 - o summary and key words in Czech/Slovak,
 - o summary and key words in English,
 - $\circ\,$ summary is to involve the goal of a contribution and methods, main results and conclusions.
 - a contribution is to involve scholarly evaluated literature (i. e. literature indexed in worldwide citation databases e. g. WoS or Scopus).
- Structure of a contribution: introduction, goal and methods, results, conclusion.
- Format of a contribution:
 - To format a contribution properly please keep the following sample:
 - Extent of a contribution: 8 pages maximum, A4
 - o <u>https://konference.vsers.cz/form/engSablonaVsers.rtf</u>
 - Title of a contribution: 100 characters maximum
 - Font: Times New Roman, size 11 pt
 - Line spacing: 1, a space between two paragraphs
 - Margins: 2,5 cm left, right, top, bottom
 - Headlines: do not use capital letters
 - Tables: tables are to be formatted in a text (not a picture)
 - Tables and pictures: are to be accompanied with headlines and sources
 - Citation: in brackets in the text of a contribution or in footnotes
- List of literature and information resources: all resources stated in the list of resources are to be cited in the text of a contribution.
- Literature: Follow the instruction sample to state the literature resources properly!
- If not respecting the instructions to authors or the contribution sample, the contributions are sent back to their authors to be completed and formatted, or may not be published. Following the instructions properly enables publishing the publication outputs in time.
- Please submit your contributions at <u>edicni@vsers.cz</u>, and title the mail "Conference Contribution 2023", another form of submitting the contributions is not accepted. Please comply with the following term of submitting the contribution by 30th September 2023. <u>The contributions delivered after the date mentioned above will not be published in the peer-reviewed collective monograph.</u>
