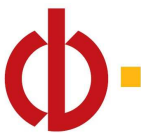

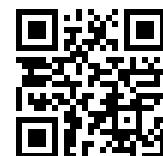

## **Aims of conference:**

The International Conference on *Sustainable Development* is a platform for discussing current issues and trends in the sustainable development of EU regions. It gives space for presenting research focused on practice in the fields of economics, management, political science, law and security sciences and space for responding to current events. In 2026, the conference aims to:

- To assess the current state of the security environment of the European Union and its Member States in the context of geopolitical changes, open borders, and increasing economic interdependence. To identify the main trends, opportunities, and risks affecting both national and collective security.
- To analyse current and emerging security threats, including hybrid operations, cyberattacks, terrorism, organised crime, and destabilising influences within the information environment.
- To discuss the economic security of the European Union, with a focus on supply chain resilience, strategic autonomy, the protection of critical infrastructure, and the impacts of globalisation and deglobalisation trends.
- To evaluate energy security in the context of energy source diversification, the transition to a low-carbon economy, the stability of energy markets, and resilience to geopolitical pressures.
- To analyse environmental security and the impacts of climate change on regional stability, migration, resource availability, and the emergence of new conflicts.
- To assess the internal security challenges facing EU Member States, including radicalisation, societal polarisation, the spread of disinformation, and the misuse of digital technologies.
- To discuss the role of digital transformation and emerging technologies (such as Artificial Intelligence, Big Data, and the Internet of Things) in the field of security, including their benefits and risks for public administration, the economy, and society.

- VŠERS staff do not pay the conference fee.

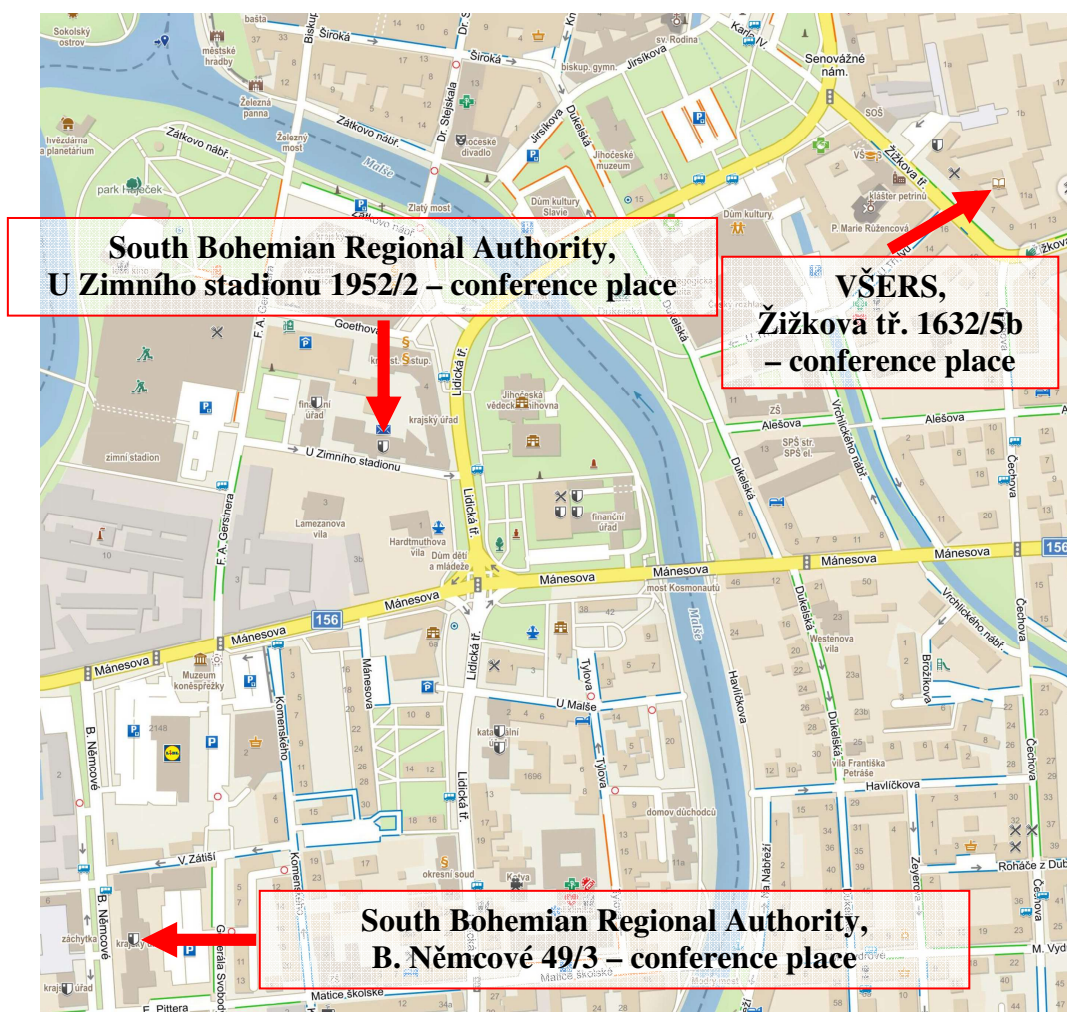
The fee includes organizational costs and costs associated with the publication of conference monographs, conference materials, food and refreshments during the conference (panels I-VII including a social event in the evening). The cost of accommodation is not included. **The fee is paid as one whole and cannot be split into individual items. Registration for the conference constitutes a binding application. By registering, the participant undertakes to pay the conference fee in full. In the event of cancellation less than 7 calendar days prior to the conference, a cancellation fee amounting to 100% of the conference fee will be charged. Substitution of a participant is possible without additional charges, provided that the organizer is informed in advance.** After paying the fee, one paper can be published and one person can attend the conference. Attendance at the conference is not conditioned by publishing a paper. Conference fees must be paid in advance by **30 September 2026**. Organizers reserve the right to cancel the registration in case the conference fee is not paid and not to include a speech or paper in the conference program and in the review procedure.

### **Instructions to authors of contributions:**

- A contribution is to involve:
  - title in Czech (Slovak),
  - title in English,
  - identification of author including contact in Czech/Slovak,
  - identification of author including contact in English,
  - summary and key words in Czech/Slovak,
  - summary and key words in English,
  - summary is to involve the goal of a contribution and methods, main results and conclusions.
  - a contribution is to involve scholarly evaluated literature (i. e. literature indexed in worldwide citation databases e. g. WoS or Scopus).
- Structure of a contribution: introduction, goal and methods, results, conclusion.
- Format of a contribution:
  - To format a contribution properly please keep the following sample:
  - Extent of a contribution: 8 pages maximum, A4

  - Title of a contribution: 100 characters maximum
  - Font: Times New Roman, size 11 pt
  - Line spacing: 1, a space between two paragraphs
  - Margins: 2,5 cm left, right, top, bottom
  - Headlines: do not use capital letters
  - Tables: tables are to be formatted in a text (not a picture)
  - Tables and pictures: are to be accompanied with headlines and sources
  - **References should be cited in the text using parenthetical citations. Footnotes must not be used for citations.**
- List of literature and information resources: all resources stated in the list of resources are to be cited in the text of a contribution.
- Literature: Follow the instruction sample to state the literature resources properly!
- **If not respecting the instructions to authors or the contribution sample, the contributions are sent back to their authors to be completed and formatted, or may not be published.** Following the instructions properly enables publishing the publication outputs in time.
