The conference is addressed to the scholars, students, public institution officers, nonprofit organisation workers as well as entrepreneurs.

Aims of conference:

The International Conference on *Sustainable Development* is a platform for discussing current issues and trends in the sustainable development of EU regions. It gives space for presenting research focused on practice in the fields of economics, management, political science, law and security sciences and space for responding to current events. In 2025, the conference aims to:

- Assess the current state of EU security policy in the context of open borders and the free movement of persons, goods and services. Identify key benefits and security risks.
- Analyse current security threats that the EU is facing including hybrid threats, cyber attacks, international terrorism, organized crime and migration pressure.
- ➤ Discuss internal security challenges of the EU Member States, such as extremism, polarization of society, the rise of disinformation or the abuse of technologies in the field of control and monitoring.
- > Explore the trends of sustainable development for the stability and growth of the EU regions.
- Create a platform for presenting research with practical applications in the fields of economics, management, political science, law and security sciences. Discuss how theoretical knowledge can contribute to solving current issues.
- ➤ Provide space for discussion and reflection of current events and political decisions affecting the EU and its members. Analyse their impacts and look for possible reactions and solutions.
- ➤ Promote cooperation between experts from different disciplines so that they can jointly seek comprehensive solutions to problems of the EU. Promote an interdisciplinary approach to research and application of results.
- Encourage participation of young researchers and professionals, enable them to present their work and take part in expert discussion. Create opportunities for their career growth and networking.
- Allow open dialogue between representatives of academia, political institutions, the non-profit sector and the business community. Encourage sharing of opinions and experiences.

Conference fee for academic staff and expert public:


- > panels I-IX + plenary session + gala dinner 2,500 CZK (100 €),

The fee includes organizational costs and costs associated with the publication of conference monographs, conference materials, food and refreshments during the conference (panels I-VII including a social event in the evening). Instructions to authors of contributions:

- A contribution is to involve:
 - o title in Czech (Slovak),
 - o title in English,
 - o identification of author including contact in Czech/Slovak,
 - o identification of author including contact in English,
 - o summary and key words in Czech/Slovak,
 - o summary and key words in English,
 - o summary is to involve the goal of a contribution and methods, main results and conclusions.
 - o a contribution is to involve scholarly evaluated literature (i. e. literature indexed in worldwide citation databases e. g. WoS or Scopus).
- Structure of a contribution: introduction, goal and methods, results, conclusion.
- Format of a contribution:
 - o To format a contribution properly please keep the following sample:
 - o Extent of a contribution: 8 pages maximum, A4
 - o https://konference.vsers.cz/form/engSablonaVsers.rtf
 - o Title of a contribution: 100 characters maximum
 - o Font: Times New Roman, size 11 pt
 - o Line spacing: 1, a space between two paragraphs
 - o Margins: 2,5 cm left, right, top, bottom
 - o Headlines: do not use capital letters
 - o Tables: tables are to be formatted in a text (not a picture)
 - o Tables and pictures: are to be accompanied with headlines and sources
 - o Citation: in brackets in the text of a contribution or in footnotes
- List of literature and information resources: all resources stated in the list of resources are to be cited in the text of a contribution.
- Literature: Follow the instruction sample to state the literature resources properly!
- If not respecting the instructions to authors or the contribution sample, the contributions are sent back to their authors to be completed and formatted, or may not be published. Following the instructions properly enables publishing the publication outputs in time.
- Please submit your contributions at edicni@vsers.cz, and title the mail "Conference Contribution 2025", another form of submitting the contributions is not accepted. Please comply with the following term of submitting the contribution by 30th October 2025. The contributions delivered after the date mentioned above will not be published in the peer-reviewed collective monograph.
